

KNIT SCRUBBIES

Pattern by Joyce Goddard

Supplies:

Two Knitting needles # 5,6,or 7

Craft netting

One strand of 4 ply Polar yarn or equivalent or two strands of any other rough 3 ply yarn

One strand of cotton yarn or string.

Preparation:

Cut the craft netting as follows:

Assuming that you have bought about 5 m of netting, fold it lengthwise several times until it measures about 20 in. (This is most easily done with the help of another person.)

Lay the netting on a cutting board and using a quilters ruler and rotary cutter cut strips about 1 ½ in. wide.

Roll these strips into a ball tying the ends together.

Construction:

Cast on: Hold one strand of Polar yarn, one strand of cotton yarn and one strand of craft netting together and proceed to cast on 10-12 stitches. The number of stitches depends upon the thickness of your yarns.

Row 1: Knit all stitches.

Row 2: and all following rows: Slip the first stitch and knit to the end on all of the following rows. Knit enough rows to make a square: about 17 or 18 rows.

Cast off all stitches.

Run the ends in down the side with a bodkin.
