How: We will have all of the materials here for you to make either type of scrubbie. All you need to bring is a pair of long or short # 6 mm or #7 mm knitting needles or a # 4, 4.5 or 5 crochet hook if you prefer to crochet.

Directions to Joyce's home are as follows: From Crowchild Trail go South on Nose Hill Drive to Scenic Acres Gate.(Third light with the Lutheran Church on S.W. Corner).Turn right and continue to T intersection (Scenic Acres Drive). Turn left. Take first right and drive to the T intersection. 39 should be right in front of you with a small motor home on the driveway. Park and come on in. From Stoney Trail take Nose Hill Drive (first road after the bridge) and come up to Scenic Acres Gate with the Lutheran Church on the left. Turn left to the T intersection and then left again. Take the first right and go to the end of the street. Our house is straight ahead with a small motorhome on the driveway.
